Message from the Executive Director



After years of substantial commercial passenger growth, Rochester International Airport maintained steady passenger levels in 2019. With no increase in air service capacity, retention of passengers from 2018 levels was key in proving the demand for local air service. There is great potential to continue expanding air service at RST and it is anticipated we will enter another period of growth in the coming years.

We have focused on experience improvements for all our customers, paying close attention to the needs of our patient travelers. We remodeled several restrooms into companion care restrooms. We have installed new seating in the gate areas offering comfortable options or the ability to work more effectively. Charging stations, new parking lot equipment and improved signage have all been investments to ensure our customers continue having a great experience each time they fly RST.

Air traffic control tower operations increased significantly this year. Over 9,000 additional operations can be attributed to an increase in private flights and flight training operations. The newly launched Rochester Community & Technical College Aviation Pilot Program powered by Great Planes Aviation has already had a significant impact on increasing the total operations at RST as students began flight training in Fall 2019.

The weight of cargo transported through RST increases as Mayo Clinic receives more test samples and increases volumes of packages received by air at FedEx and with other contract operators.

The Minnesota Department of Transportation Office of Aeronautics recently released a state-wide economic impact study of airports. The study illustrates the vast impact an airport has on a region's economy and employment. With robust commercial, cargo and general aviation operations at RST, the impact to the region is impressive. Rochester International Airport generates a \$190 million economic impact on our region annually. RST supports more than 1,600 jobs with a total payroll of \$63 million annually.

RST serves as a critical economic driver and as such requires an intense focus on maintaining infrastructure to remain operational around the clock. We are looking ahead and planning for our major needs as we complete our Master Plan in the coming year. The Runway Safety Improvement project is critical to continuity of operations. We are working diligently with our partners locally, at the state and federal levels to achieve the funding package necessary to complete this \$79.2 million project.

2019 was a successful year for the RST Team. We look forward to a bright future and anticipate more growth and improvements in the coming years.







Rochester Community & Technical College (RCTC) Flight School Buildout

In 2019, RCTC launched a new Aviation Pilot program powered by Great Planes Aviation based at RST. To accommodate a learning environment at the airport, a project remodeled an existing space attached to a hangar on the general aviation ramp. The space includes classroom seating and a full motion flight simulator. Students began both classroom instruction and flight training in Fall 2019 with anticipation of the program doubling in size in future years.

Runway Safety Improvements

RST will undertake a multi-year runway safety improvement project including the reconstruction of Runway 2/20 which has reached the end of its useful life and is no longer able to be kept in use with ongoing maintenance. Improvements to associated taxiways and instrument landing systems will also occur. A planning study and environmental analysis will begin in 2020.




Operating Costs and Excess Revenues
