The process through which the approved action is being updated is a Supplemental EA, which, if approved, will become part of the 2021 EA. The overall project has not changed in any substantial way and the FAA's environmental approval of the project through the FONSI/ROD is still in effect for project components that were included in the 2021 EA. The need for this Supplemental EA is to assess any environmental impacts of project components that have been slightly modified or were absent from the original EA. These supplemental project components are shown on the enclosed Figure 3-11.
